

As Jesus was sending his disciples in mission, he warned about the challenges ahead. He said that they will be hated by all because of his name. But they should not be afraid because they will be under the protection and the care of God. Jesus said to the Twelve: "Fear no one. Nothing is concealed that will not be revealed, nor secret that will not be known. What I say to you in the darkness, speak in the light; what you hear whispered, proclaim on the housetops." There is no doubt the disciples will face obstacles, challenges and difficulties that will put their body under stress, but they should be afraid of that.
