Dear family,

“Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul”

As Jesus was sending his disciples in mission, he warned about the challenges ahead. He said that they will be hated by all because of his name. But they should not be afraid because they will be under the protection and the care of God. Jesus said to the Twelve: “Fear no one. Nothing is concealed that will not be revealed, nor secret that will not be known.
